

2011 Team Texas Cadet Duals FAQ

Q: Does only the state tournament champ qualify?

A: Yes, for the 2011 Cadet Duals only the state tournament champion automatically qualifies.

Q: What about different FS and GR champs in the same weight class?

A: First preference is to take both – one could primarily wrestle GR and the other FS, or they could alternate through the week. HOWEVER, we are very limited on plane seats. If some wrestlers choose to find their own transportation then we can/will take additional wrestlers in cases such as this. For cases where we cannot take both, the criteria is:

1. wrestler willing to wrestle both styles
2. wrestler also going to Fargo (must put deposit down)
3. TX-USAW Board decision which may consider items such as regional representation and recommendations from the team coaches

Q: Can wrestlers arrange their own transportation (for example, as part of a family vacation)?

A: Yes, however they must arrive in time for the team practice before weigh-ins, and they must stay with the team during the tournament. Wrestlers who provide their own transportation will receive a \$200 discount on the team fee ONLY IF ALL TEAM SEATS ON THE PLANE ARE COVERED.

Q: If the state champion decides not to go, does it go to the runner-up?

A: The next highest placer earns the right to qualify for the Cadet Dual team.

Q: Are there options to participate for wrestlers willing to travel on their own (say as part of a family vacation)?

A: Yes. These wrestlers will be considered for any open spots on the roster and as alternates. Wrestlers who provide their own transportation will receive a \$200 discount on the team fee ONLY IF ALL TEAM SEATS ON THE PLANE ARE COVERED.

Q: How will alternates be selected?

A: There are many factors for choosing alternates. ALL wrestlers wishing to be part of the team should complete an application and submit a deposit by May 8. Deposits WILL be returned for any wrestlers not qualifying or not selected as an alternate. Criteria for selection:

1. wrestler willing to wrestle both styles
2. alternates will be spaced throughout the weights to provide flexibility in filling holes
3. extenuating circumstances for not competing in the state tournament
4. wrestler also going to Fargo (must put deposit down)
5. TX-USAW Board decision which may consider items such as regional representation and recommendations from the team coaches.

Q: What happens if a wrestler cannot make camp due to travel issues?

A: The camp is a vital part of the Duals for proper preparation and training. Any wrestler missing camp must have direct approval in advance from the Cadet Duals coaches.
